

Introduction

On November 28, 2007, the Stewardship Council adopted the Final Land Conservation Plan (LCP Volumes I and II). The adopted Plan included a section entitled “Public Comments and Response to Comments on LCP Volumes I and II.” This section of the Plan consisted of a compilation of public comments received on the Draft Land Conservation Plan as well as a response to these comments prepared by the Stewardship Council.

After the Final Land Conservation Plan was adopted, it was determined that some additional public comments had been inadvertently omitted. Consequently, these comments have been compiled and a response has been prepared for each individual comment. The comments and responses are contained in Addendum 1, which was reviewed by the Stewardship Council Board of Directors and adopted on March 26, 2008, and Addendum 2, which was reviewed by the Planning Committee and adopted on April 23, 2008.

How to Use this Document

This addendum document presents additional public comments and associated responses that relate to Volume II of the LCP. These comments are organized by watershed and planning unit. To find a particular comment, please refer to the appropriate watershed and planning unit, and then look for a particular name in the alphabetized “Commenter” column (alphabetized by first name).

Numerous comments were made regarding the Kennedy Meadows Planning Unit within LCP Volume II. Many of these comments consisted of mailed form letters (see Appendix 1 of November 2007 “Public Comments and Response to Comments on LCP Volumes I & II” for an example form letter). For these form letters, the comment text states “Form letter - see comment from Matt Bloom” and is followed by any additional comment text provided at the end of the form letter. The response to the form letter states “See response to Matt Bloom form letter comment.” Please reference the response to the comment by Matt Bloom in the November 2007 “Public Comments and Response to Comments on LCP Volumes I & II”. If additional text was provided within the form letter, it is included within the comment text and an appropriate response is provided.
