<p>In the lower Bear River planning unit, only the lands in T.8N-R16E Sections 13 & 24 should be managed as if they were wilderness. All lands outside the wilderness boundaries should not be managed as wilderness.</p>	<p>Brian Oneto, District 5 Supervisor</p>	<p>No</p>	<p>Comment noted. The recommended measures are intended to be illustrative in nature. In this case, the intent is to complement wilderness values on the adjacent Watershed Lands, not to implement management prescriptions that would be the equivalent of a wilderness management approach. Additionally, the recommended measures are not intended to drastically change existing land management, but rather to preserve the wilderness character of Watershed Lands that are either in holdings or adjacent to designated wilderness.</p>
<p>There should be no change to the (L.D.S.) Camp Ritchie.
